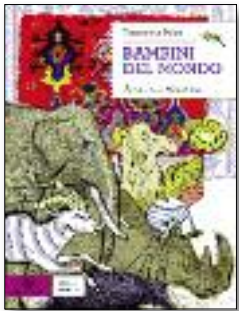


The Magical Games of Toys

Davide Morosinotto - THE FREE KINGDOM OF BOYS

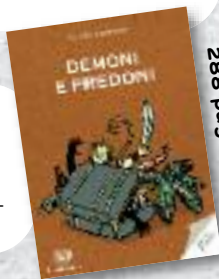

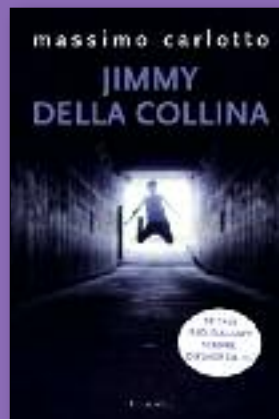


Jimmy from the Hill
